The desired certificate is as follows -

- (1) No. of institutions already existing in the State - Five (5)
- (2) No. of seats available or No. of dental surgeon being produced annually - no. of seats 400.
- (3) No. of doctors registered with the State Dental Council - around 750
- (4) No. of doctors in Government service - around 104
- (5) No. of Government posts vacant and those in rural/difficult areas - 200
- (6) No. of Dental surgeons registered with Employment Exchange - Not available as the doctors generally not registered with emp. exch.
- (7) Dentists population ratio in the State - 1:1,50,000
- (8) How the establishment of the college would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified dental personnel in the State and improve the availability of such dental manpower in the State. -

*Proposed Dental College shall produce approximately 100 dental doctors each year which shall enable the State to bring the dentist population ratio closer to the norms and also to maintain it. Looking to the number of vacancies existing in Govt. and non Govt. sector, it is expected that most of the pass-out Dentists shall remain in the state and offer their services to the rural and tribal areas of the state.*

- (9) The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State, be specified. -

*15% seats in state run dental colleges are reserved for the central quota which are available for the students Non domiciled in the State.*

- (10) Full justification for opening of the proposed college - *Number of dental College in the State remained static to one since last 4 decades and only three private dental colleges have come into existence in last 2-3 years. All these private colleges are yet to produce qualified dentists as all of the three have been established only one or two years back. M.P. is a State with preponderance of Tribal and rural population who need good dental services and services of qualified dentists badly. Further, Indore division is having a population of 78 lacs, the majority of which belong to scheduled caste (SC) and scheduled Tribe (ST). This is evident from the fact that 4 out of 6 parliamentary and in all 28 legislative assembly constituencies are reserved for SC/ST communities. The talent from these weaker sections of society remain deprived of dental education because they can not afford to go to distant places for education. Hence there is a dire, very genuine and fully justified need for establishment of a new dental college in the area.*

(11) Doctor - patient ratio proposed to be achieved - 1:20000


*Sri Aurobindo Institute of Medical Sciences* has applied for establishment of a Dental college at *Urban village Bhanwarsala, Indore*. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of *Madhya Pradesh* has decided to issue an essentiality certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Dental College with 100 seats.

It is certified that :-

- (a) The applicant fulfills all the requirements and norms to establish a new dental college as laid down in BDS course regulations framed by Dental Council of India and approved by the Central Government under the Dentists Act 1948
- (b) It is desirable to establish a dental college in the public interest.
- (c) Establishment of a dental college at *INDORE* by *Sri Aurobindo Institute of Medical Sciences* is feasible
- (d) Adequate clinical material as per the Dental Council of India norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the dental college as per DCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the Students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.


Sir,
