Note to all: 1. The recognition so granted to a Postgraduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
2. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Postgraduate Course.

This is with reference to your application for increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course from 04(Four) to 10(Ten) seats at Sri Aurobindo Institute of Medical Sciences, Indore under Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

It has been noted that in your letter No. SAIMS/13/207, dated 28.03.2013, you have raised the issue that the Hon'ble High Court of Jabalpur, Indore Bench had directed in it's order dated 19.03.2013 to dispose of the pending representations of your institute and communicate it's decision on or before 28.03.2013 but the representations dated 12.2.2013, 12.3.2013 & 13.3.2013 have not been decided till date and the information requested by this institute, too, has not been supplied with. You have also stated that as per the Hon'ble High Court's order, your institute can submit it's compliance / rectification / justification upto 31st March, 2013.

In this regard, it may be noted that the entire file pertaining to your College's application for increase of seats, including your representations dated 12.2.2013, 12.3.2013 & 13.3.2013 were duly placed before the Board of Governors and the Board of Governors in compliance of the High Court order after reviewing the entire material placed before them in their meeting held on 28.03.2013 have taken the decision in respect of your application.

The Board of Governors considered the contents of the Council letter dated 26.03.2013 and letter No. SAIMS/13/207 dated 28.03.2013 received from Sri Aurobindo Institute of Medical Sciences received on 28.03.2013 at 4.45 pm observed that the college has not submitted any explanations/compliance about the observations about discrepancies of salary of various faculty member mentioned in paras no, 1 and 2 of page 2 of the Council letter dated 26.3.2013.

The Board of Governors on perusal of annexure 1 of pathology noted that there is no explanations about discrepancy of salary and not able to relate the case paper/death certificate of Dr. Saroj Munjal with present case.

In view of the above, the Board of Governors observed that the College has not been able to furnish any credible explanations/compliance about deficiencies/observations pointed out in the Council letter dated 26.03.2013. In view of the foregoing the Board of Governors decided to reiterate earlier decision i.e. approved for increase of MD (Pathology) seats from 04(four) to 06(six) seats.



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


